

Simple Present Tense & Present Continuous Tense







From the above conversation, we can see that simple present tense is used to talk about habits and present continuous tense is used to talk about something that is going on at present.

Simple Present Tense is used:

- 1. to show **facts** or **universal truth**
- e.g. The sun **rises** in the east.

Salt **dissolves** in water.

- 2. to show habitual actions or things that always happen
- e.g. Peter **goes** to school by bus.

We always **visit** our grandma twice a week.
