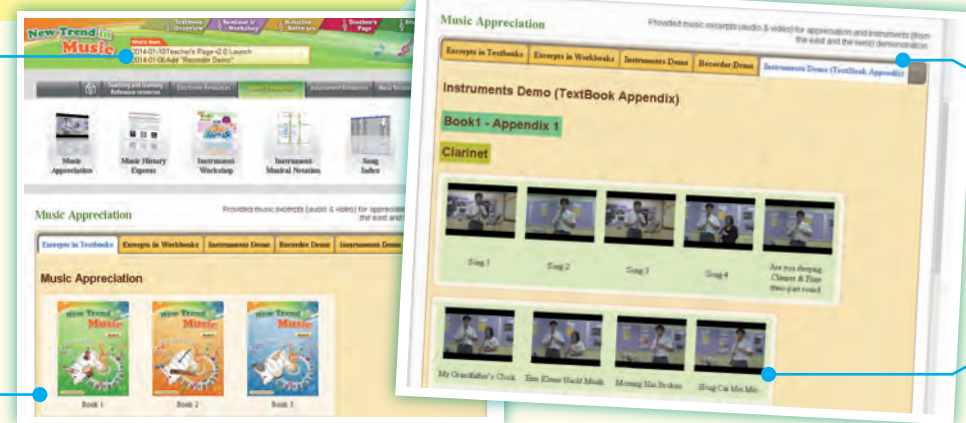

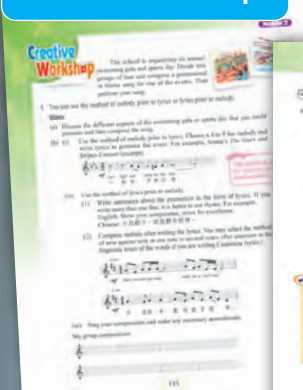

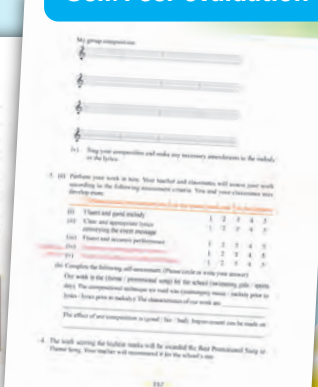

Students will work in groups and complete the creative tasks according to their abilities. Students can enrich creativity and gain satisfaction through applying musical knowledge and skills.

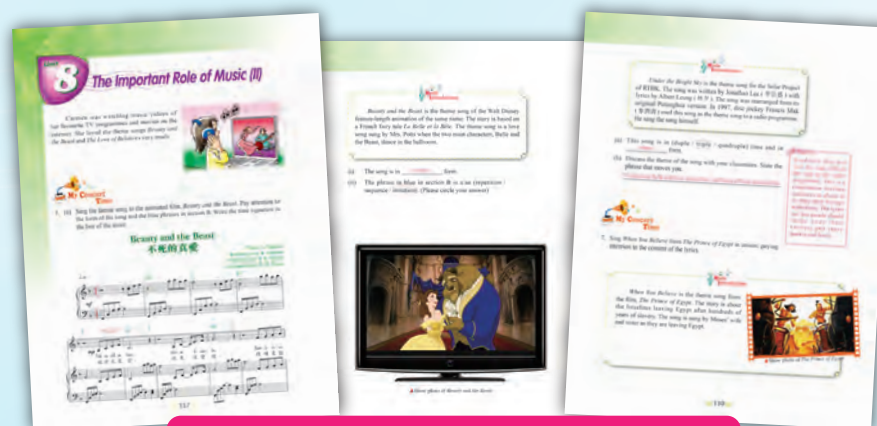

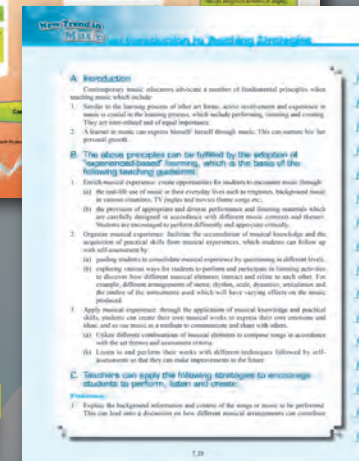
Experience
